Scripture Passage: James 2:1-13      Message: “Grace that Overcomes Guilt”

- ❖ **If I violate just one small point of God’s law, am I really guilty of breaking ALL of God’s law?** “Whoever keeps whole law, yet breaks one – is guilty of all it!” (2:10)

All of scripture testifies to this \_\_\_\_\_ truth.

Our confessions stand as a witness to this \_\_\_\_\_ truth.

- ❖ **How can I be truly confident that God in his \_\_\_\_\_ absolutely shows no favoritism to anyone?** “Mercy triumphs over judgment.” James 2:13

God’s mercy is \_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 5:45, Romans 2:11).

God’s mercy is \_\_\_\_\_ (Psalm 106:1; Psalm 136).

- ❖ **How can I be absolutely certain that God in his \_\_\_\_\_ personally covers me with the perfect obedience of Christ?** “God who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgression—it is by grace you have been saved.” (Eph. 2:8).
