Minister: As we prepare to celebrate holy communion, let us remember that Scripture calls us to examine ourselves before God. May the celebration of our Savior's infinite love in his redeeming death bring joy to us and glory to God. Let us pray together in one voice.

All: We thank you, heavenly Father, for the atoning power of our Savior's death and for our share in his victory over sin. Open our hearts as we prepare for this celebration, that it may strengthen us in our faith, establish us in our hope, and confirm us in our love. In his name, Amen.

Prepare us by your Holy Spirit for the sacrament. Help us to come in the assurance that by it we shall be spiritually revived only through the shed blood and broken body of Christ our Lord. Amen.
