Introduction

Brothers and sisters in Christ, the sacrament of baptism reminds and assures us that we share in the death and resurrection of Christ, and are incorporated into Christ's holy church. Baptism proclaims the faith of the church. The water of baptism is a sign and seal of God's promise to cleanse us from sin, renew us, and reconcile us to Himself in Christ.

Baptism is the sign and seal of God's promises to His covenant people. In baptism, God promises by grace alone to forgive our sins, to adopt us into the body of Christ, the church, to send the Holy Spirit daily to renew and cleanse us, and to resurrect us to eternal life. This promise is made visible in the water of baptism. Water cleanses, purifies, refreshes, sustains; Jesus Christ is The Living Water.

Vows

David and Gina, since you have presented Micah Jonathan for baptism, we ask you the following questions before God and his people. Do you promise:
to instruct Micah in the truth of God's Word,
to direct him in the way of salvation through Jesus Christ,
to pray for him,
to teach him how to pray, and
to train him in Christ's way by your example, through worship, and in the nurture of the church?

We do, God helping us.

Congregation:

Do you promise to love, encourage, and support David and Gina?

Do you join them in teaching Micah the gospel of God's love?

Do you join them in being an example of Christian faith and character?

Do you promise to give them the strong support of God's family in fellowship, prayer, and service?

God of grace and truth, send your Holy Spirit, we pray, that this water may be a spring gushing up to eternal life. Wash away Micah's sin, raise him to new life. Graft Micah into the body of Christ.
